NON COUNCIL CONTRACTOR ACCESS TO

LLANVACHES PLAY AREA AND GLEBELANDS FOOTBALL FIELD

In order to protect the trees in the playing field, some of which have been planted by villagers, the following conditions are to be adhered to:

- 1. No trees on Community Council leased land are to be cut without prior agreement and assessment by Llanvaches Community Council.
- 2. Residents are only authorised to cut back any overhang in their own gardens.
- 3. The Community Council will assess each request and either ask Newport City Council to carry out any works or employ its own contractors.

N.B Residents requesting the Community Council to have trees cut down should cross reference Newport City Council's Tree Policy.

All requests are to be submitted in writing and will be for the Council to consider at the next available meeting. Requests should include the following:

- 1. Sight of Public Liability Insurance (not the schedule) prior to commencement of the works.
- 2. Contractor to provide a copy of their Risk Assessment and / or Safety Method Statement prior to commencement of the works.

If the request is grant the following will need to be adhered to:

- 1. A nominated Councillor to be on site to ensure that gates are locked whilst the work is carried out.
- 2. Immediate area of work to be cordoned off with hazard tape.
- 3. Contractors to discuss with the Community Council what works is being carried out.
